

OUR HISTORY ...

Originally formed in 1984, the Community Improvement Committee was a cooperative formed between the residents and original developer, Harold Schwartz, having 14 members (two members from each of the seven original Orange Blossom Gardens developments).

In 1985, the CIC became an official organization and formed a leadership committee consisting of President Harvey Wood, a vice president and a secretary. The CIC drafted their first set of by-laws.

As the community grew, so did the CIC. By 2011, the number of officers expanded to include a second vice president and an assistant secretary.

Today, the CIC has 40 members, and continues to act as a liaison between the residents, the developer, and the VCCDD to improve our community.

The Community Improvement Council is dedicated to promoting and protecting our clean, fun-filled, friendly, safe lifestyle by being responsive to the residents of The Villages.
