Here are a few examples, residents suggestions submitted to CIC have led to wheelchairs at Rec Centers and the Squares, lowering/trimming the height of landscaping at traffic circles and cart paths to improve visibility, swimming pool maintenance, improved street signage, improved street lighting, landscaping upgrades, and safety flashers to make residents more visible when walking around their neighborhood after dark or early morning.
